- \*\*If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact Century Bathworks or your dealer for replacements.








• Cut Bar 11/4" shorter than opening width.




• Measure opening width, where header bar

mounts to walls




• Measure down 3" from unit height ordered & drill mounting holes on each wall


Determine location of stationary panel. (Left or Right side)
Mount wall brackets on wall. Remove stationary panels screw caps
with tool provided.




· Assemble roller as shown.








• Place wall mount collars on bar & lift bar into place. (Note: one of each end of bar) fastener collars to wall mount brackets on each side of opening. Make sure bar is level.





• Place base channel on base & fasten to base. Placing 1/4"shims in base of channel.





• Lift Stationary panel into position & place over mounting screws into base channel and onto bar & into bottom guide.













• Lift sliding door and attach top rollers onto door glass.






• Now attach lower rollers onto sliding door. Double check that the sliding door is operating smoothly. Make sure door doesn't roll on side of the other. Adjust bumper stop so door doesn't hit wall & so handle doesn't come in contact with edge of stationary panel glass.



• Attach handle to door. Attach L-vinyl to wall where sliding door closes against to prevent water leakage.





• Caulk entire unit. Optional: use T-vinyl to stop any water from escaping shower on base where door slides. Optional: use L-vinyl on edge of panel glass to keep water from escaping between the sliding door & panel. Optional: use L-vinyl on wall where closes to prevent water leakage. Check and confirm smooth operation of door.
